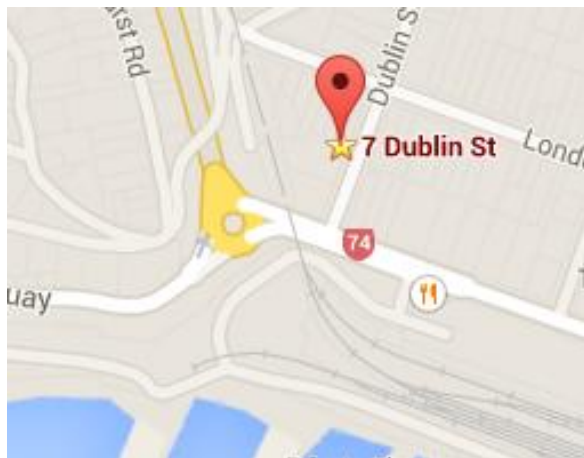

Dear Lyttelton resident,

This is an invitation to become a “Friend” of Lyttelton Community House

The “House” situated in Dublin Street offers a number of services to the community, including, but not limited to:

- A drop-in centre
- A weekly community lunch
- A meals on wheels service up to 5 days a week for those recommended for it by the medical centre
- Outings on a monthly basis (roughly) for people largely shut in
- Assistance in getting to & from the shops on Wednesdays for those who need it
- Assistance with the preparing of CVs
- Advocacy for individuals and the community
- Organisation of a Qigong class for the elderly
- Providing transport to a CCC Walking group in Beckenham
- Promotion and Support to Lyttelton Menz Shed
- The celebration of Matariki and commemoration of Parihaka
- Supporting the Weekly vegetable collective

The Cost of these services is largely met from grants from central and local government agencies such as lotteries, the community grants scheme and the Christchurch City Council along with the assistance of private charitable groups such as United Way or the Manchester Unity fund and Food stuffs. However demands for these funds are high and we need other forms of support.

We have a number of “Friends” in the community already including Starks who provide the building, the newly opened Supervalu supermarket and of course our volunteers, who cook the meals, deliver the meals, assist with Tuesday lunch, and provide numerous other services. More Volunteers would always be welcome.

However many people who appreciate the work of Lyttelton Community House have not the time to volunteer, because of work or other commitments.
