### **Community Lunch**

The community lunch is held every Tuesday 12.30 – 2 pm where a free meal is provided. This is a time to share a meal and a conversation with others in a friendly safe supportive environment

### **Community Shopping Shuttle**

### **Matariki Celebration**

Maori New Year- Matariki Celebration is held every year in June. This event is organised jointly between LCH and local iwi and Project Port Lyttelton.



### **Parihaka Commemoration**

Every year on 5<sup>th</sup> November we commemorate this peaceful protest which ended with a number of men from Parihaka, Taranaki forced off their land and imprisoned without being charged in the Lyttelton Gaol, and other locations throughout New Zealand.
